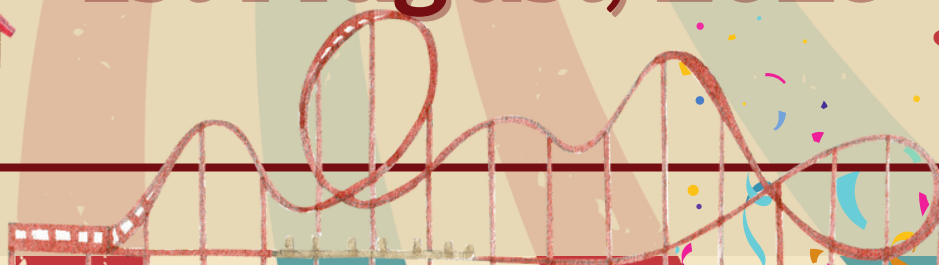

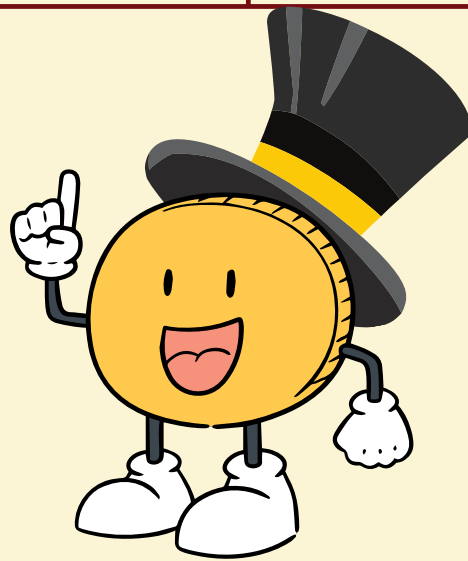
RULES AND REGULATIONS

ACCOUNTING RELAY


“Race to Balance the Books!”


Accounting Relay is a fast-paced, team-based event where participants sprint through the entire accounting cycle – one step at a time!

Each team member handles a specific task: from recording journal entries to ledger posting, trial balance preparation, and even creating final accounts.

The catch? It's a relay – the next member can start only after the previous one finishes and submits their work. This event tests speed, accuracy, coordination, and core accounting skills.

 Mode: Offline

 Team Size: 3–4 participants

 Duration: 30–45 minutes

Rules & Regulations:

- Each team must consist of 3 or 4 members.
- Tasks must be completed in sequence, with the next task starting only after receiving evaluator approval.
- No communication or assistance among teammates is allowed during the event.
- All answers must be written clearly and legibly.
- The use of mobile phones, books, or external help is strictly prohibited.
- Teams will be disqualified for violating rules or switching tasks.
- All decisions made by the evaluators are final.

FINANCE TAMBOLA


“Play the Numbers. Learn the Concepts.”


Finance Tambola gives a financial twist to the classic game of housie! Instead of numbers, participants receive tambola tickets filled with finance-related terms – like inflation, SIP, GDP, UPI, budget, tax, and more.


The host will call out clues or definitions, and players must identify the term and strike it off their ticket. The game continues with excitement, laughter, and lots of learning!

 **Format: Paper Tambola Tickets with Finance Terms**

Rules & Regulations:

- Each participant receives one printed Finance Tambola ticket.
- The ticket will have 15 finance-related terms arranged in a 3×5 grid.
- The host will announce definitions, scenarios, or word hints.
- Participants must strike out the correct matching word on their ticket.
- Winners must call out their win clearly.
- The claim will be verified by the organizer before confirmation.
- Incorrect claims will lead to disqualification from that round.

PITCH IT RIGHT

Rules & Regulations:

- Each participant or team must pitch a finance-related idea.
- Time limit: 2–3 minutes for the pitch, plus 2 minutes for judges' Q&A.
- A maximum of 5 PowerPoint slides is allowed.
- Props or visual aids may be used.
- Political or plagiarized content is not allowed.
- Teams must stick to their time slot or face point deductions.
