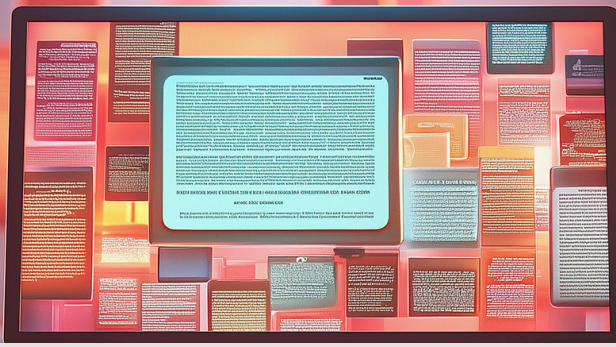

- Title of the paper - 14 points font size
- Name of Author(s) and their complete affiliation i.e.
- College/Institute name, Affiliating University etc.
- Abstract (Maximum 200 words)
- Keywords (Maximum 5)
- APA Style Reference should be used

- Selected papers to be published in reputed peer reviewed journal.
- A Plagiarism check certificate must be attached with the full research paper.
